


PATRIOTIC SERVICE DOG FOUNDATION

is a non-profit organization focused on serving our veterans by raising awareness for their needs and providing Service Dogs to those who may benefit from long-term mental and physical assistance.



These conditions can lead to sleeplessness, depression, anger, anxiety and isolation. While these feelings can be overwhelmingly difficult, they are treatable, but so many continue to suffer in silence.

The Patriotic Service Dog Foundation's goal is to reduce that statistic from "22 to Zero".





OUR MISSION

Through donations solicited from the general public the organization will provide support for the raising, care, and training of service dogs from puppyhood to Certification with a recipient as a "Service Dog Team". We will also support the ongoing dog/recipient training as needed to ensure a mutually beneficial dog/recipient relationship.



Certified PTSD Dogs can perform tasks such as:

- Interrupt and redirect handler from nightmares and anxiety behaviours
- "Cover Me" task to watch handlers back
- "Block" stepping in front of handler to create a barrier for personal space.
- Balance/Brace
- Retrieve
- Turn lights on/off
- "Pull" assists in opening doors
